This month's approvals deadline has now passed and all proposals to develop new apprenticeship standards; draft standards, and draft assessment plans, have been put online as part of our short approvals surveys, to give all interested parties a chance to comment.

You may also wish to promote the survey to your wider sector contacts, particularly if they did not have the chance to input during your own consultation. Please all draft consultations listed by name of job standard and indicated department/area for feedback.

Healthcare Jobs Standards

The Senior Healthcare Support Worker Level 3 apprenticeship Job Standard and End Point Assessment has now been approved and is now ready for use with the following options for:

- Adult Nursing
- Maternity Support
- Theatre Support
- Mental Health Support
- Children (in development)

A Funding Band of 4, £3,000 has been allocated to both the Level 3, Senior Healthcare Support Worker and to the Level 2 Healthcare Support worker apprenticeship job standards. The Healthcare Standards Trailblazer Group intends to appeal this decision however requires sufficient evidence to present to the government regarding the cost of delivery of these job standards. If you intend to provide the training for these job standards, please contact Lucy Blinko regarding attending a special meeting on 6 December 2016 in London. Please see attached email.



To date, Pearson have informed employers and learning providers they have applied to be an End Point Organisation for all Healthcare and Healthscience apprenticeship job standards.
